Course	Duration (days)	Identified Need
CIEH Level 3 Award in Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector Introduces the knowledge and skills required by teachers to develop and deliver programmes, provide learning support and take responsibility in managing the learning process in post-16 education.	5	
CIEH Level 2 Award in Health & Safety in the Workplace Designed to ensure that all employees are aware of their own safety and the safety of customers, contractors and the public.	1	
CIEH Level 3 Award in Health & Safety in the Workplace Provides a thorough understanding of health and safety emphasising the importance of monitoring staff and controls. Also details the need for a structured management approach to health and safety and the key factors in implementing health and safety policy.	3	
CIEH Level 4 Award in Health & Safety in the Workplace Provides managers and supervisors with knowledge and understanding of the issues involved. It is also suitable for those wishing to deliver CIEH health and safety qualifications as part of their training provision.	5	
CIEH Level 2 Award in Food Safety in Catering Everyone who works with food has a special responsibility for safeguarding the health of consumers and ensuring that the food they serve or sell is perfectly safe to eat.	1	

CIEH Level 2 Award in Fire Safety Principles

Aimed at employees who are to have a designated responsibility for workplace fire safety e.g. fire wardens or fire marshals. This provides the knowledge that will allow them to carry out duties relating to fire safety and emergency procedures.

More suitable for lower-risk work environments, such as offices and shops and/or organisations with fewer than 100 employees.

Course	Duration (days)	Identified Need
Senior Managers' Awareness This course raises awareness of the importance of health and safety strategy to senior levels of management within the organisation. It outlines responsibilities as determined under the terms of health and safety policy as well as legal duties.	1	
Accident Investigation At the end of this course delegates will be able to carry out accident investigations, identify causes and be able to make recommendations to prevent further incidents. Delegates will also learn what is reportable under RIDDOR.	1	
COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health) This course provides delegates who work with hazardous substances with the key knowledge relating to the COSHH Regulations 2002.	1	
DSE (Display Screen Equipment) Delegates attending this course acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to become a risk assessor, meeting the requirements of the Display Screen Equipment Regulations in the workplace.	1	
Fire Awareness / Fire Marshal Course This two part course for all employees raises awareness of fire and the importance of keeping combustible materials separate from sources of ignition. The second part provides delegates with the knowledge and skills to become a competent Fire Marshal.	1	
Health & Safety Awareness This course provides basic awareness for all employees. It examines workplace hazards, identifies risk and establishes a method of control.	1	

Course	Duration (days)	Identified Need
<p>Manual Handling</p> <p>Provides the vital knowledge to help reduce the risk of injury including back problems. This can reduce lost working days and protect the business from potential claims.</p>	1	
<p>Risk Assessment</p> <p>This course puts an emphasis on practical exercises so that delegates can perform risk assessments in their own organisation.</p>	1	
<p>Environmental Awareness</p> <p>This is becoming increasingly popular as the 'duty of care' expands to waste. This course outlines areas of air, land or water that could become contaminated as a result of a particular incident. It also looks at energy conservation regarding transport, electricity etc.</p>	1	
<p>Stress Awareness</p> <p>This course has been established in order to give employees and managers a clear understanding of the impacts of stress and explains stress management techniques.</p>	1
